GENERAL NOTES

HydraSoil[®] is a specially formulated soil wetting agent designed to improve water penetration into water repellent soils. Maximises water uptake without causing excessive movement through the soil profile. This reduces the problem of nutrient losses or nutrient leaching away from the plant root zone.

APPLICATION RATE: HydraSoil[®] is applied either by boom spraying or can be spot treated or band treated. Once applied, HydraSoil[®] should be washed off the leaf surface as soon as possible and drenched into the soil.

TANK MIXES: HydraSoil[®] is only compatible with products that need to be drenched into the soil. D0 NOT apply with products that must persist on, or near soil surface.

SITUATION	DOSE/RATE	COMMENTS
Turf	250mL/100m ²	Apply every 4-6 weeks during late spring and summer.
Pot Plants/Gardens	2mL/L	Drench into pots or apply to media before transplanting. Top ups may be needed every 6 weeks.
Broad-acre Sowing	500mL/L in 60-100L of water	Apply at seeding with trailing wetting agent applicator mounted behind a furrow sowing combine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Rinse container and dispose in an environmentally responsible manner.
