



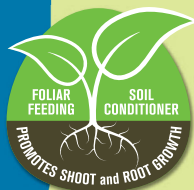

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- For advice on application with spraying systems, please refer to the Technical Data Sheet.
- Always dilute with water before applying.
- Agitate well before decanting or mixing into spray tank.
- Check physical compatibility (jar test) and also whether spray tank mixes are allowed, before making a spray tank mix with other agrochemicals.
- Add Yates Uplift Fish last when making a spray tank blend.
- Do not store diluted product, use within 24 hours.
- Do not apply to foliage in the heat of day or if shade temperatures exceed 30°C.
- Safe to use on pastures grazed by ruminant animals.

Maximum dilution 1:250. Minimum dilution 1:50.

Foliar application (General recommendation: apply every 3-4 weeks in the growing season)

Vegetables & turf	4-8 L/ha
Orchards	5-10 L/ha
Grapes	5-8 L/ha
Cereal & broadacre	2-5 L/ha
Pasture	5-10 L/ha

Apply higher rate just after fruit set or grazing/cutting.

Soil drench application

10-40 L/ha. Use higher rate for poor soils.

Fertigation application

Apply soil drench rate prior to final flush of lines at 1:100 dilution.

Seedling application

Apply at 1:250 dilution rate.

Avoid inhalation and contact with eyes and skin. Wash hands immediately after use.

STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Avoid exposure to excessive temperatures.
